Dear Anthony,

I am writing to acknowledge that GlobeTec Construction, LLC (GlobeTec) has been under contract with the City of Fort Lauderdale for the construction of sanitary sewers and associated improvements since June 2006, (including water main and road and right-of-way restoration), has completed approximately \$15.5 million worth of improvements to-date and their progress and performance has been excellent.

GlobeTec has been contracted with the City under what we refer to as a General Services contract, where work is identified generically in a Proposal for bidding purposes, including all the items expected to be necessary for a "typical" sanitary sewer construction project. Contracts are awarded on a low-bid basis based on the unit pricing and estimated quantities (quantities expected to be somewhat representative of the work to be assigned). Specific work is then assigned in individual work orders (which in essence become individual contracts). Additional work is assigned subject to continued good performance and progress, and demonstration of sufficient resources to successfully take-on that additional work.

GlobeTec has continually made good progress and done good work, has cooperated in negotiating changes and claims, and has done an excellent job of addressing the impacts of their construction. Much of their work has taken place in established residential communities, and sanitary sewer work can be extremely disruptive in such environments – GlobeTec has successfully answered that challenge.
